## **Emergency Communication & Preparedness Wallet Card**

When a disaster occurs, communication systems could be disrupted or overwhelmed almost immediately. Incoming phone calls to the affected area code might be shut down to give priority to emergency operations. To prepare for emergency communication, you can designate emergency contacts, create a family communication plan, and complete a Family Preparedness Wallet Card.

**Emergency Contact:** Arrange for an out-of-town relative or friend to be your emergency contact. Your contact should live outside of the affected area, preferably in another part of the country. Make sure to program the emergency contact in everyone's cell phone.

**Family Communication Plan:** Create a plan for all family members to check in with your emergency contact. The emergency contact can relay information about those who have checked in. This will provide peace of mind for your household and loved ones, and will help keep incoming local lines open for emergency personnel. If cell towers are still functional, send a text message instead of trying to call wherever possible. Texting takes less cellular signal to send than a voice call.

Please discuss with your family the importance of staying off of phones and internet other than a brief check in. It is critical that lines remain open for emergency personnel.

**Family Preparedness Wallet Card:** A Family Preparedness Wallet Card is a vital part of your family emergency communication plan. The wallet card contains important information at a glance, all in one place. Create a wallet card and then give a copy to each person in your household to carry with them at all times. Be sure to give a copy of the wallet card to your emergency contact person.
